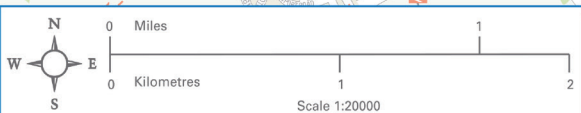
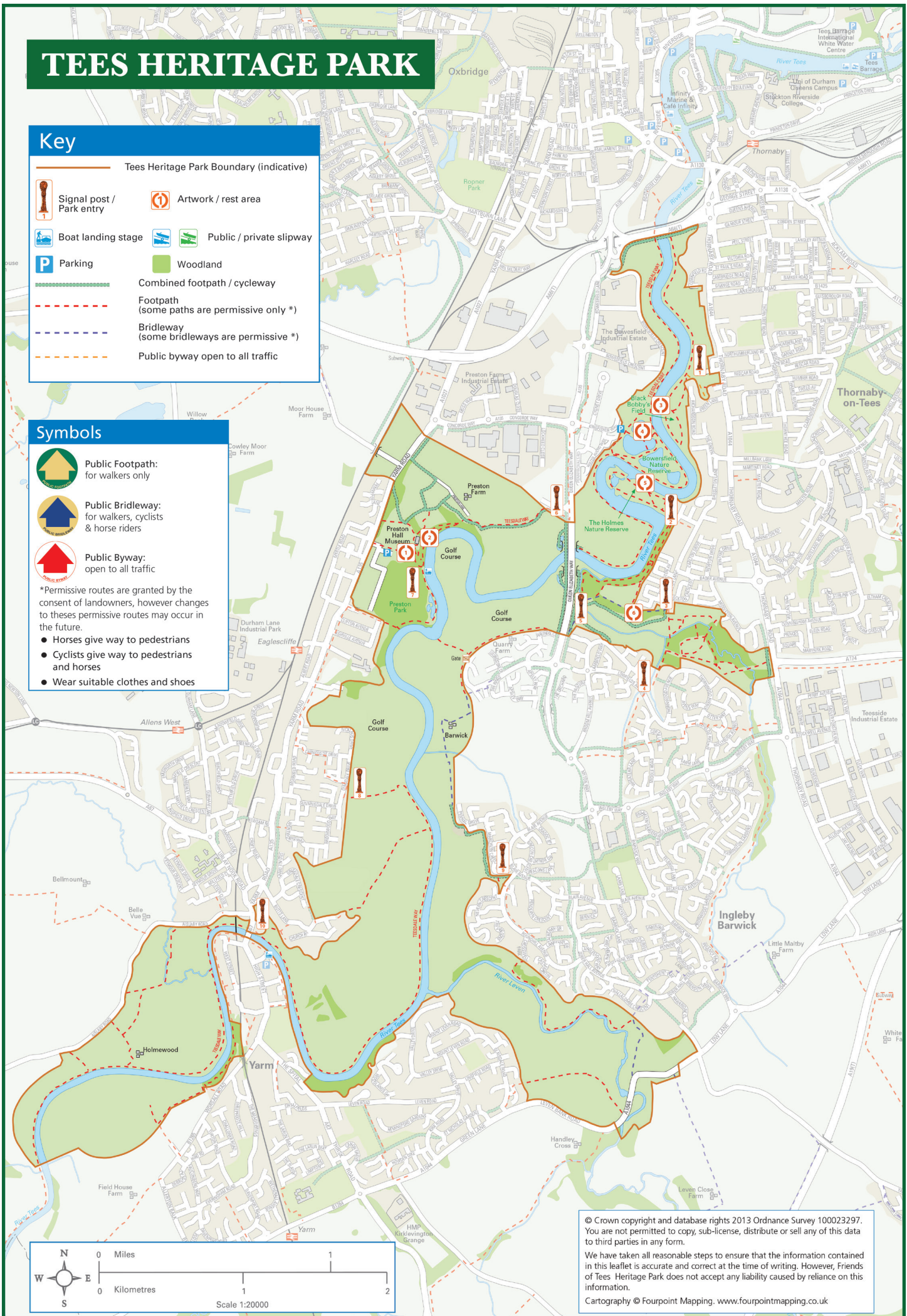
-  Tees Heritage Park Boundary (indicative)
